

Certificate of Land Sold for Taxes.

Shelby County, I, G. W. Weaver, Tax Collector of said County,

hereby certify, that the following real estate lying in said County, to-wit: NE¹/₄ of SE¹/₄ & NW¹/₄ of NE¹/₄ Sect of Lin House Branch of part NE¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ of SW¹/₄, Sec. 18 Tp. 18 R. 1 E. was assessed by the Tax Assessor of said County to Lathrop Lumber Co. for the State and County taxes for the year 1913; that the said taxes became delinquent and an application of which due notice was given was regularly made to the Probate Court of said County for a decree for the sale of said land for the payment of the taxes and charges thereon; that a decree was rendered by said Probate Court on the 5th day of June 1914 for the sale of said land as prescribed by law, and after having given notice of sale by posting same at the Court House of said County in the precinct where said land lies at least three weeks before the day of the sale, and also by advertisement for three successive weeks in the Peoples Advocate a newspaper published in said County at least thirty days before the day of sale in pursuance

of said decree and notice of sale, said land was on the 11 day of July 1914, offered for sale at public auction at the court house of said County, between the hours of 10.00 A.M. and 4.00 P.M. of said day, and at said sale J.L.
