

This indenture made and entered into this 9th day of
March 1858 between Edward H. McGinnis, Sr. M. McGinnis,
Paul R. McGinnis, John B. McGinnis, William C. McGinnis
and Lucy McGinnis of Shelly County, Alabama of the first
part and William Walker of the State and County afore-
said of the second part, witnesses that we the said
parties of the first part for and in consideration of the
sum of fifty Dollars to us in hand paid, the receipt

whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and delivered and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto the said party of the second part a certain tract or piece of land, known as the N. W. 1/4 of S. E. 1/4 of Section No. 12, T. 18, R. 1 East, in the Tuscaloosa land district and State of Alabama, containing forty acres more or less, unto him the said party of the second part, his heirs &c. To have and to hold this aforesaid conveyed premises with all the appurtenances thereto he lawfully or in anywise lawfully, in anywise appurtenant. And we the said parties of the first part bind ourselves, our heirs, executors & Administrators and assigns to warrant, defend and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid land to the said party of the second - his heirs and assigns in fee simple against the claims of all manner of persons whatsoever claiming the same under any law in the United States.
