 It is covenanted that the said parties of first - part and in con-
 sideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty \$500
 to them in hand paid by the said parties of the second
 part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the

said portions of the first part have bargained sold and do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said portions of the second part the following described real estate lying in the County of Shelby, State of Alabama, to wit: $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $N.E\frac{1}{4}$ $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $N.E\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, Township 19, Range One East.

To have and to hold to the said portions of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever. And the said R. B. McCoy and J. J. McCoy of the first part, Covenant with the said Colby Jackson of the second part that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises that they are free from all encumbrances, and that they have a good right to sell and convey the same, that they will and their heirs executors and Administrators shall warrant and defend the same to said Colby Jackson of the second part and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims of all persons.
