 Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part for and in
 consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to them in hand
 paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged the said parties of the first part
 have bargained and sold and do by these presents
 grant bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of
 the second part the following described real estate lying
 in the County of Shelby State of Alabama, to-wit: All
 that part of S. 1/4 of S. E. 1/4 of Sec. 21 Township 19 Range
 1 East West of the Dickerson branch lying and being in
 the County and State aforesaid containing thirty acres
 more or less. To have and to hold to the said party of

the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever. And said Michael Dorr and J. J. Dorr, husband and wife of the first part to grant with the said William P. Dorr of the second part that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all incumbrances, and that they have a good right to sell and convey the same; that they will and their heirs, executors and Administrators shall warrant and defend the same to said William P.
