

State of Alabama,) Know all men by these presents That Whereas
 County of Jefferson (the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company
 by deed dated August 25, 1914, conveyed to the Tennessee Land Company
 certain real estate situated in the West half of the South-East quar-
 ter of Section 13, Township 22 South of Range 6 West, Bibb County,
 Alabama, particularly described in said conveyance in exchange
 for other real estate hereinafter described; and
 Whereas Article Five of the deed of trust executed by the said
 Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company in favor of the
 Union Trust Company of New York, Trustee dated July 1, 1901,
 and securing an issue of Fifteen Million Dollars of bonds,
 provides for the release of property embraced in said deed
 of trust, where said property has been conveyed in exchange
 for other property, the property received in exchange to forthwith
 become and be subject to the lien and operation of said deed
 of trust as fully as if the same had been originally in-
 cluded therein.

Now therefore in consideration of the release by the Union
 Trust Company of New York, Trustee under said mortgage
 or deed of trust dated July 1, 1901 of the real estate above re-
 ferred to as having been conveyed by the Tennessee Coal, Iron
 and Railroad Company to the Tennessee Land Company
 and in further consideration of One Dollar to the Tennessee
 Coal, Iron and Railroad Company in hand paid by the
 Union Trust Company of New York, Trustee, receipt whereof
 is acknowledged, the said Tennessee Coal, Iron and Rail-
 road Company does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey
 unto the said Union Trust Company of New York, Trustee
 the real estate conveyed to the Tennessee Coal, Iron and
 Railroad Company by the Tennessee Land Company, said
 real estate being described as follows:

1, The North-West quarter of the South-East quarter; and the South
 half of the South-East quarter of Section 34; and the West half
 of the South-East quarter of Section 35; all in Township 22 South
 of Range 4 West, Shelby County, Alabama;

2. The East half of the South-West quarter and the North-West quarter of the South-West quarter of Section 34, Township 20 South of Range 4 West, Shelby County, Alabama; Reserving and Excepting however, all the coal, ore, minerals and metals in, under or upon said land, and also all timber, water and stone upon the same necessary for the development, working and mining of said coal and other minerals, and the preparation of the same for market and the removal of the same, and also the right of way and the right to build roads of any description over the same necessary for the convenient transportation of said coal and other minerals from said land and the conveying and transporting to and from said land all material and implements that may be of use in the mining and removal of said coal and other minerals or in the preparation of the same for market.
3. A tract of land described as follows: Begin at the Northwest corner of the South-West quarter of the South-East quarter of Section 13, Township 22 South of Range 6 West; thence north 2 degrees and 47 minutes west 402.1 feet; thence south 67 degrees and 33 minutes east 113.3 feet; thence north 22 degrees and 27 minutes east 365 feet; thence south 67 degrees and 27 minutes east 656.2 feet; thence south 15 degrees and 05 minutes west 123.2 feet; thence south 74 degrees and 54 minutes east 149.8 feet; thence north 15 degrees and 11 minutes east 82.1 feet; thence south 74 degrees and 49 minutes east 389.5 feet; thence south 15 degrees and 11 minutes west 881 feet; thence north 74 degrees and 49 minutes west 539.5 feet; thence south 15 degrees and 37 minutes west 328.9 feet; thence south 43 degrees and 04 minutes east 164 feet; thence south 45 degrees and 45 minutes west 577.5 feet; thence south 2 degrees and 47 minutes east 33.21 feet; thence north 87 degrees and 21 minutes west 335.13 feet; thence south 87 degrees and 13 minutes west 31.3 feet; thence north 2 degrees and 47 minutes west 580.3 feet to point of beginning; said described tract of land being situated partly in the West half of the South-East quarter and partly in the North-East quarter of the South-East quarter of Section 13, Township 22 South of Range 6 West, Bibb County, Alabama, and containing 25.2 acres more or less; Reserving and Excepting, however, all the coal, iron ore and other minerals in, under and upon said tract of land, together with all the timber and water upon the same necessary for the development, working and mining of said coal, iron ore and other minerals and the preparation

To have and to hold unto the said Union Trust Company of New York, Trustee its successors and assigns forever.

This conveyance is made supplementary to the mortgage or deed of trust heretofore executed by the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company in favor of the Union Trust Company of New York, Trustee hereinbefore referred to, and the property hereby conveyed is conveyed upon the trusts, for the purposes and subject to all the provisions of said mortgage or deed of trust, as fully as if specifically embraced in same.
