heirs, executors and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

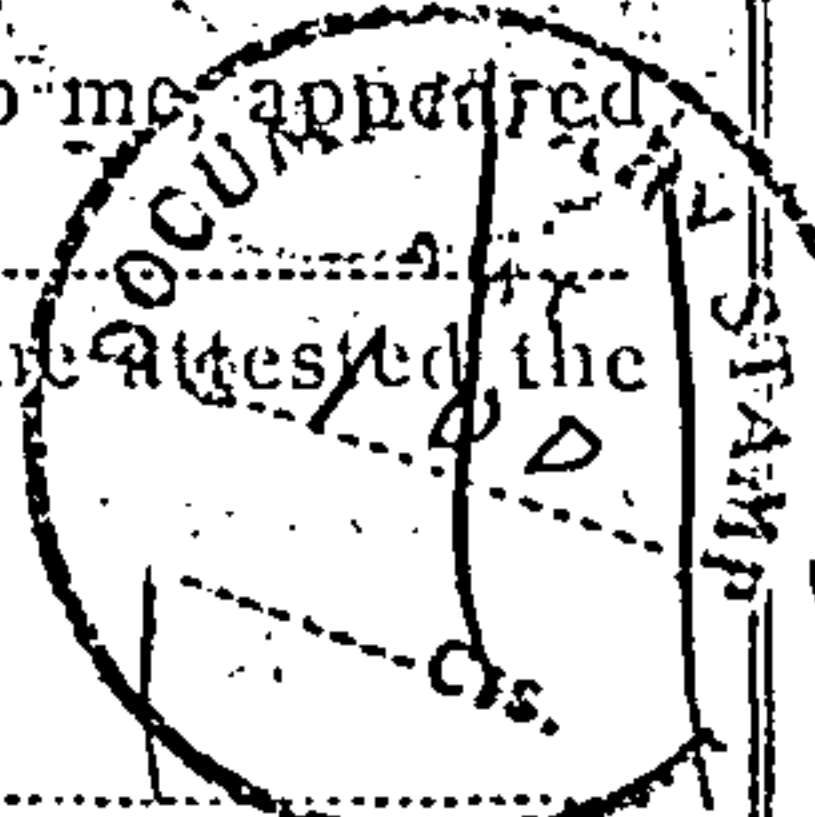
