To all to whom these presents shall come greeting: Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery Alabama, whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress (approved 20th May 1862) "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of John M. Vandiver, has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the Southeast quarter of the South East quarter of Section ten in Township eighteen South of Range one East of Huntsville Meridian in Alabama, containing forty acres and fifteen hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said John M. Vandiver, the tract of land above described; To have and to hold, the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said John M. Vandiver and to his heirs and assigns forever.

For Testimony whereof Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the city of Washington, the fifteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, and of the Independence of the United States, the one hundred and seventeenth.
