 Jefferson County, Ala this the 20th day of February, A.D. 1884
 between John T. Heflin of Jefferson County Alabama, by the first
 part and John A. Griffin of Shelby County Alabama of the sec-
 ond part,
 Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of one
 hundred and sixty five dollars, this day paid by the said
 John A. Griffin to the said John T. Heflin, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, the said John T. Heflin has remised,
 released, and forever quit-claimed and does hereby remise
 release and forever quit-claim to the said John A. Griffin

and to his heirs and assigns forever the following lots, Tracts or parcels of land, to wit, part of the northeast quarter of section four of Township Twenty one and Range three west containing one hundred and thirteen and a half acres more or less; also a fractional part of the northeast quarter of section four in Township twenty one, and range three west containing twenty-five acres more or less, described as follows, beginning at a point on the south line of the west half of said quarter section fifty four poles west from the southeast corner of the aforesaid section, thence running west to the Elyton and Montevallo road, thence north along said road to the Broadhead Spring Branch, thence along said branch to its mouth, thence across Bearcreek Creek to the west line of the half quarter section, thence eastwardly ninety poles to a fixed post, sixty two poles north of the southern boundary line of said quarter section, thence south eastwardly to the aforementioned beginning corner. Also a part of the South East quarter of section thirty three, in Township twenty and Range three west, beginning where the south line of said township crosses Benjamin Scribner's Spring Branch, thence west with said line to Bearcreek Creek, thence down said Creek with its meanderings to the mouth of said Scribner's Spring branch, thence along said branch with its meanderings to the beginning point, containing twenty five acres more or less, said lands being in Shelby County, Alabama. To have and to hold the above described and hereby renewed, released and quit-claimed lands to the said John A. Griffin his heirs and assigns forever, from and against the said John T. Hefflin his heirs and assigns and from and against all persons, claiming said lands from or under the said John T. Hefflin his heirs or assigns on testimony, whereof & the said John T. Hefflin has hereto set his hand and seal on the day and year first above written.
