 and convey to the said Electa S. Starrs, all my right, title, in-
 terest or claim in or to the following described land to-wit:
 The lot of land now occupied by the said Electa S. Starrs in
 the city of Montevallo, with all the appurtenances thereto be-
 longing, being the same property (except 75x50 feet sold heretofore
 in the southwest corner,) which was conveyed by Edmund
 King to Martha A. Starrs dated March 6, 1869 and recorded in
 Deed Book N. Page 701, Shelby County, Ala. Same being devised
 by the last Will and testament of Martha A. Holbrook, relict
 of John S. Starrs to said Electa S. Starrs. Said lot commences
 at a point 75 feet North from the North East corner or inter-
 section of Walnut (or North Boundary Street) with Valley Street
 running thence along the East side of said Walnut (or
