State of Alabama,) This Indenture made and entered into
Shelby County, on this the 11th day of February 1910
by and between the undersigned Jno. P. Haynes of the
County of Shelby in said State part of the first part

and J.R.Taylor of said County and State part of the second part
Witnesseth - That,

Whereas a Mortgage was executed on the 19th day of November
1914, by Austin M. Hunt and wife Mary J. Tucker Hunt Robert
W. Tucker, Pattie S. Tucker and Mary R. Tucker of Shelby County
Alabama, to J.R. Taylor on certain property herein after described
which said mortgage is recorded in Record Book Volume
103, page 269 of Mortgage Record of Shelby County Alabama,
in the office of the Judge of Probate of said County of Shelby
State of Alabama; and

Whereas in and by said mortgage, said J.R. Taylor was authorized
and empowered in case of default in the payment
at maturity of the debt secured thereby, to take possession
of said property, and after giving notice of the time,
place and terms of sale in some newspaper published
in Shelby County Alabama, once a week for two successive
weeks to sell the same at public outcry, for cash
to the highest bidder and which said mortgage pro-
vides that in case of sale under the power and authority
contained in the same, the auctioneer selling said
property was authorized and empowered to execute title
to the purchasers at said sale; and

Whereas default was made in the payment of said
mortgage debt at maturity of the same, and said prop-
erty was advertised and sold in all respects as provided
in said mortgage, on the 11th day of February 1915, after no
tice thereof, as provided in said mortgage for two suc-
cessive weeks in the Shelby County Daily, a newspaper
published in Shelby County Alabama, at which said
sale J.R. Taylor did become the purchaser, at and for
the sum of Four hundred fifty five and $\frac{3}{10}$ Dollars, this
being the highest and best bid the said J.R. Taylor
being the original mortgagor was authorized and em-
powered by the terms of said mortgage to become the
purchaser at said sale.

Now therefore in consideration of the premises, and of
the sum of Four hundred fifty five and $\frac{3}{10}$ Dollars, in
hand paid to me by the said party of the second part
the receipt whereof upon delivery of these presents here-
by acknowledged, the said party of the first part, has

granted, bargained and sold and by these presents does grant, bargain sell and convey to the said party of the second part, the following described real property to wit: Lot two, three and four in Block # 11 excepting part of lot four, heretofore described by grants to W. M. Sparks, and also the west half of lot five in block # 11, commencing at a point on the north side of Lot Five 170 feet West of Third Street, thence running West 194 feet along the line of said lot to hill side first 65 feet, thence East 195 feet, thence North 63 feet to point of beginning. All being in the town of Helena, Shelby County, Alabama, according to the Joseph Squires map, the same being the same property deeded to us by Mallie P. Tucker and her husband prior to the execution of the date and witnessed by deed executed together with all privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining.

To have and to hold the said above described property unto the said J R Taylor, the party of the second part and unto his heirs and assigns, as fully and completely in all respects, and the said party of the first part covenanted or ought to convey the same under and by virtue of the power and authority vested in him by the terms of said mortgage.
