 Shelby County That whereas on the 7th day of Feb-
 ruary 1912 the undersigned Mrs. R. Edmondson sold
 and conveyed to Perry Milner the land hereinafter de-

 Milner sold and conveyed said land to S. S. Childers;

old house place and east of the road that runs from the old house place and east of the road that runs from the old place to the upper bridge, and on the west side of Miller Leaf Creek and the creek is the line from bridge to bridge containing 60 acres more or less.

To have and to hold unto the said S. D. Childers his heirs and assigns forever.
