Calhoun County } into this the 29th day of January
1889 between Mary E. Taylor and W. H. Taylor her husband

of the 1st part and Amos Daniel of the 2nd part, Witnesseth. That for and in consideration of the sum of Three thousand one hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part hath this day granted, bargained and sold and by these presents, grant, bargain sell and convey unto the party of the second part his heirs forever, the following described land lying in Shelby County, Alabama to wit: The South-West quarter of Sec. Six, Township 21, Range 2 East and all of that part of the North West quarter of Section Six, Township 21, Range Two East lying South of the East Tenn. Va. & Ga. Railroad, Also the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Sec one, Township 21, Range one East, a total of Two hundred and fifty acres more or less. To have and to hold the above described lands together with all the rights and privileges thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the said Amos Daniel, his heirs or assigns forever: and the said party of the first part for themselves their heirs, executors and administrators hereby covenant with the party of the second part his heirs and assigns, that they are seized of title in fee simple in said land and that they will forever warrant and defend the title thereof against the lawful claims of all persons whatever.
