 lying and being, in the said County of Shelby and
 State of Alabama to wit: All that part of the NW 1/4
 of Section 15, that lies west of Shoal creek and
 north of the Achille road and south of a certain

ditch and cross fence, and all that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 16, that lies east of another cross fence south of said ditch, and north of the Achille road, and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 23 which said land was heretofore owned by Martin M. Perry, now deceased, and known as the Martin Perry land and being in Township 22 south, Range 3 West. Also the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 25, Township 21, south Range 3 West, known as the Perry timber land; also an undivided one half interest, being the interest heretofore owned by Ruth E.
