 towers poles and appliances necessary or convenient in
 connection therewith upon a strip of land one hundred
 feet in width as the same is now located by the final
 location survey thereof heretofore made by said Company
 over and across the lands of which it is herein after
 described as being a part together with all the rights
 and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoy-
 ment or use thereof for the purposes above described
 including the right of ingress and egress to and from
 said strip and the right to cut and keep clear all trees
 and undergrowth and other obstruction on said strip and
 danger trees adjacent thereto where necessary.
 Said strip is a part of a tract of land situated in Shelby
 County, Alabama described as follows: North half of the North
 half of section 24 Township 17 South of Range 1 East. Said
 strip is substantially described as follows: Fifty feet
 on each side of a line and the continuations thereof
 beginning on the west boundary of said section 24
 at a point 740 feet north from the southwest corner
 of the North West quarter of the northwest quarter of
 said section and running thence north 81 degree

56 minutes east to a point on the north boundary of said Section 24. Said strip is also a part of a tract of land situated in St. Clair County Alabama, described as follows: North-East quarter of the South-East quarter of Section 18, Township 17, South of Range 2 East; said strip is substantially described as follows: All that part of the North-East quarter of the South-East quarter of Section 18 which lies within 50 feet of a line beginning on the east boundary of the South East quarter of said Section 18 at a point 26 feet south from the north-east corner of the south-east quarter of the South-East quarter of said Section 18 and running thence south 78 degrees 56 minutes West;

Said strip is also a part of a tract of land situated in St. Clair County Alabama, described as follows: South half of the South-West quarter of Section 18, Township 17 South of Range 2 East; said strip is substantially described as follows: Fifty feet on each side of a line and the continuation thereof, beginning on the west boundary of said Section 18 at a point 239 feet north from the southwest corner of said section and running thence north 81 degrees 56 minutes east for a distance of 46.5 feet; thence north 78 degrees 56 minutes east to a point on the east boundary of the South-West quarter of said Section 18.
