 and telephone lines, towers, poles and appliances neces-
 sary or convenient in connection therewith upon a strip
 of land one hundred feet in width, as the same is
 now located by the final location survey thereof
 heretofore made by said Alabama Power Company over
 and across the lands of which it is hereinafter described
 as being a part, together with all the rights and
 privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment

The east half of the southwest quarter and the northwest quarter of Section Twenty six, and the west half of the southwest quarter of Section Twenty three all in Township Twenty South, Range Three West.

Said strip is substantially described as follows:

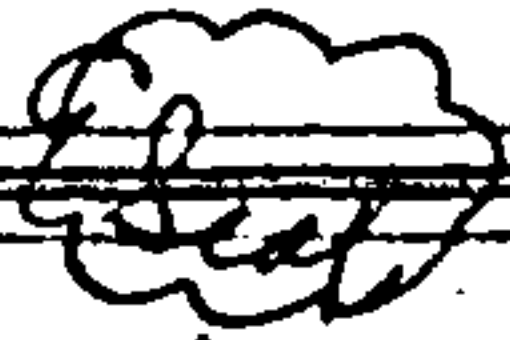
Fifty feet on each side of a line and the continuation thereof beginning at the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of said Section Twenty three, and running thence south 23° 02' east for a distance of 5888 feet more or less, to a point on the east boundary of the southwest quarter of said Section Twenty six, said point being south 75 feet from the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of said Section Twenty six.

To have and to hold the same to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns forever.
