About 15 acres situated in the $\text{SE}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, and
in the $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 20, in Twp 18 S. Range 2 East de-
scribed as follows: Beginning at a point on the south-
west side of the right of way of the C. of Ga. Ry 270 feet
southeast of where the line between the $\text{SE}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$ and

situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

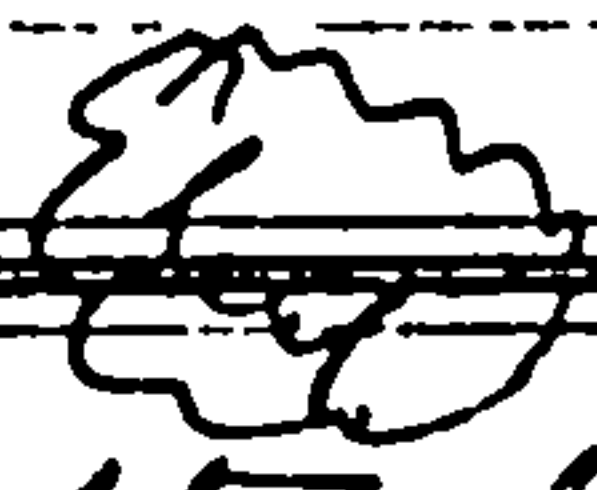
