

Ex Parte.

No. 264 In the County Court of Shelby
County in Equity.

In the matter of the petition of H. L. Campbell for the removal of the disabilities of non-age of Carl Campbell. This cause coming on to be heard having been duly continued to this date was submitted in term time for final decree upon the petition, and the affidavits of J. M. Mite, E. E. Flory, and M. E. Vincent.

It appearing to the court that the petitioner is the father of Carl Campbell a minor over the age of eighteen years; that said minor has no guardian; that a copy of said petition together with a copy of the decretal order of this court setting a day for the hearing of this petition, was duly served on said minor by the sheriff as required by statute and by the terms of said decretal order and no one appearing to contest the granting of said petition; and it appearing to the satisfaction of the court from the affidavits, presented in accordance with the directions of said decretal order, that it will be to the interest of said minor to be relieved from the disabilities of non-age:

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court, that the said Carl Campbell minor who is over the age of eighteen years, he and he hereby is relieved of the disabilities of non-age and that he and he hereby is vested with the right to sue and to be sued, to contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate and generally to do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if twenty one years of age.

It is further ordered that petitioner H. L. Campbell

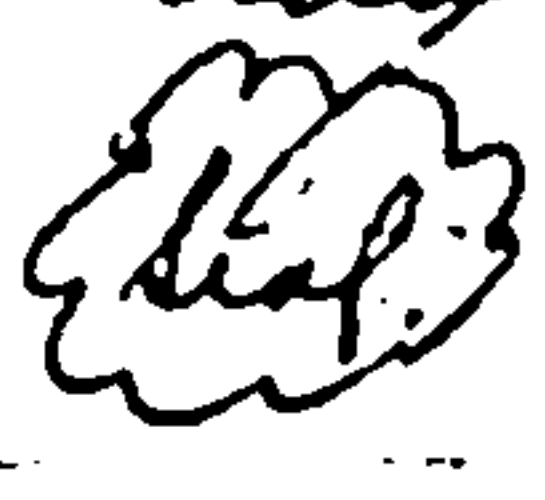
