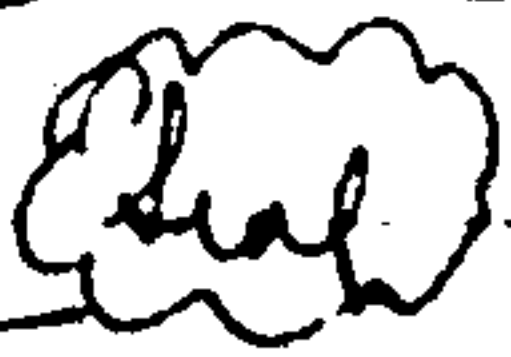


The State of Alabama, } Know all men by these presents

 of due dollar and other valuable considerations to
 the undersigned grantor Alabama Colony Company -
 a corporation under the laws of Alabama, in lawful

 bama, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 it the said Alabama Colony Company does grant
 bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. Lee
 Long the following described real estate to wit:
 The North-West quarter and the West half of the
 South-east quarter, Section Thirty six (36) Township
 Eighteen (18) South, Range one (1) West Huntsville Meridian
 containing two hundred and thirty eight and
 ninety five hundred (238.95) acres and the West
 half of the West half of Section twenty-five (25)
 Township Twenty-four (24) Range fifteen (15) East, St.
 Stephens Meridian the same being that part
 of fractional Section twenty five West Coosa River
 except that part heretofore sold to Alabama
 Power Company situated in Shelby County Alabama
 To have and to hold unto the said J. Lee Long his
 heirs and assigns forever.

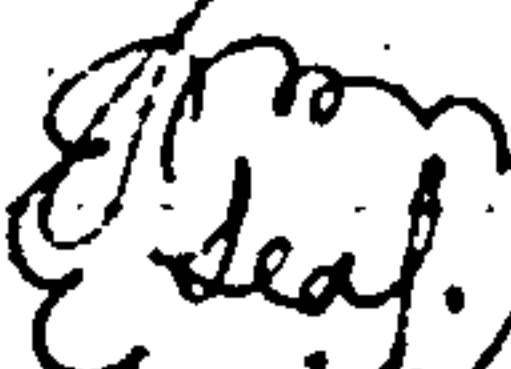
And it does for its assigns and transferees ex-
