 Shelby County, } That we Sarah E. Nabors widow and
 L. N. Nabors Beber Nabors Jr. and F. May Lyman the only
 surviving heirs at law of French Nabors deceased; and
 Alice M. Nabors wife of said L. N. Nabors, and E. S. Lyman
 husband of said F. May Lyman for and in consid-
 eration of the sum of five dollars to each of us, in
 hand paid by Alabama Girls Technical Institute
 a public corporation, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, and for other good and sufficient con-
 siderations do hereby grant, remise, release, quit-claim
 and convey to said Alabama Girls Technical Institute
 all our right, title, interest, claim and estate, in and
 to the following described real estate lying and being
 in the Town of Montevallo, Shelby County, Alabama to wit
 All that part of what is known as and called North
 Boundary Street, which lies and extends northwest
 of Oak Street, and all that part of King Street ac-
 cording to the survey and plan of Lyman's Addi-
 tion to the Town of Montevallo, which lies between
 said North-Boundary Street and a new street

to be opened to connect Oak with King and Highland streets, along the northeast line of the Starns and Mahaffey lots and all that part of said King street which lies between the northwest line of Highland Street, and the southeast line of Block Street according to the said survey and plan as recorded in the probate office of said Shelby County; said parts of streets hereby conveyed to be closed and vacated as public streets, and said new streets opened in accordance with the terms of "Ordinance A-4, of the Town of Montevallo, approved May 10, 1915; it being understood that at the time said King and North Boundary Streets were opened and dedicated as such Edmund King, to whose title interest and estate therein, the said Nabors heirs have succeeded by means conveyances and inheritance was the owner of the tract of land traversed by said King Street and of the abutting lot on the northeast side of said part of North Boundary Street hereinbefore described.
