That he is acquainted with the location of Lot No. 437
of the N. B. Dane survey of cedar, made for Shelby Line

Avenue and running back east along the north

That he purchased said lot from J. L. McElroy and
wife in the year 1894 and in 1896 sold and
conveyed the same to Sallie M. Laubam and that
Sallie M. Laubam afterwards married one B. J.
Skinner and that in the year 1909 the said
Sallie M. Skinner and husband sold and con-
veyed the said lot back to him, affiant and
that in August 1914, affiant conveyed the west
150 feet of same to E. C. Kinney
That affiant took immediate possession of said
when he first purchased the same from said
McElroy and continued in possession of the
same until he sold it to Mrs. Sallie M. Laubam
and that Mrs. Laubam immediately took possession
of said lot where she bought it and continued in
said possession until she and her husband

B. Skinner conveyed it to affiant during the year 1907
and that affiant immediately took possession of the
same and continued in said possession until he
conveyed the same to said E. C. Kimney.
That the said possession of said lot above named from
the time affiant first purchased the same until
