

The State of Alabama, } Whereas S. M. Dinkins executed to G. T. Pike County } Stallings a certain mortgage on the 22nd day of March 1898 for the sum of eight hundred and twenty five Dollars due January the 1st, 1899 upon the following described land to wit: Two hundred and fifty (250) acres lying in sections 5 and 6 T. 24 R. 13 and bounded as follows: On the north by the Southern Railroad, and lands of Jno. P. Randall, on the west by lands of P. T. Randall; on the south by the Monterallos and Calera dirt road; and on the east by the road leading from said Monterallos and Calera road to the line line on the said Southern road, known as Carey Randall's line line, lying and being in Shelby Co. Ala. And whereas said mortgage contained a power of sale by which said Stallings in case of default in the payment of said note is authorized to sell said land to the highest bidder for cash in the town of Prunedge Pike County Alabama after giving ten days notice of such sale by posting at the post-office in said town of Prunedge at which sale he is authorized to become the purchaser. And whereas said land was advertised to be sold under said power by posting written notice of the time, place and terms of sale at the post office in said town of Prunedge for more than ten days next before the 19th day of October 1900, on which it was advertised to be sold.

And whereas I Johnathan Williams was requested by the said G. T. Stallings to sell said land agreeable to said notice of sale, and whereas I did offer said land for sale in said town of Prunedge on the 19th day of October 1900, at 1 o'clock P. M. under the power of sale in said mortgage and whereas the said G. T. T. Stallings is the purchaser of said lands under said power of sale and that the facts above stated are true.
