 tree, thence West 40 or 50 yards to the place of beginning, containing
 3 acres more or less on the N.E. side of S. R. 14 of S. 6 T. 10
 Township 20 Range 3 West. Then Commencing at N.E. corner of the
 Block, thence West 279 yards to the N.W. corner, thence South
 along the top of the ridge, water divide to public road, thence along
