 Witnesseth that the said Party of the First Part for and in Consideration of
 the sum of One thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars to her in hand paid the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and
 sold and doth by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto
 the said Party of the Second Part and unto his heirs ^{and} assigns the
 following described real estate to wit:

Lots Sixteen(16), seventeen(17) and eighteen(18) in the plan of the
 Town of Columbia except so much thereof as is covered by the
 public road, running from what is now the old Court House - south-
 west in the direction of W. B. Morris' Residence, being the same
 land sold by Mary P. Roper to Am. Elliott by deeds dated October 29th
 1873 and recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County

Alabama in Volume 13 page 230 situated in the town of Columbian,
Alabama.

The land herein Conveyed being known as the A. M. Elliott Homestead,

of all persons.
