

State of Alabama,) Know all men by these presents,
 County of Jefferson } that for and in consideration of
 One Dollar to the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad
 Company in hand paid by the Southern Railway Com-
 pany receipt whereof is acknowledged, the said Tennessee
 Coal, Iron and Railroad Company a corporation, hereby
 grants unto the said Southern Railway Company a cor-
 poration a right of way fifty feet in width for a spur
 track extending across land of the Tennessee Coal, Iron
 and Railroad Company in the South East quarter of
 North-West quarter and the North-East quarter of South-
 West quarter of section 9, Township 21, South of Range 4 West
 Shelby County Alabama, in location shown by map hereto
 attached and made a part of this instrument, for the
 purpose of serving saw mill operations in the quar-
 ter-quarter section first described, said right of way
 being twenty-five feet wide on each side of the center
 line of said spur track;

To Have And To Hold, the said Southern Railway Compa-
 ny its successors and assigns upon the following
 conditions:

(1) That the title to the right-of-way herein conveyed
 shall revert to the grantor herein, its successors or
 assigns when said spur track is no longer required
 for serving aforesaid saw mill operations;

(2) That after the grantee herein, its successors or assigns
 shall discontinue serving aforesaid saw mill operations
 and within sixty days after notice in writing from
 the grantor as to do, said grantee its successors or
 assigns shall without expense to the grantor herein
 its successors or assigns remove all rails and other
 material contained in said spur track from the land
 described;

(3) That the grantor herein, its successors or assigns

shall have a right to construct across said spur track railroads, tramroads or wagon roads at grade or otherwise, as well as telephone, telegraph and other electric transmission lines, in such manner however as will not interfere with the use of said spur track by the grantee herein, its successors or assigns; and,

(4) That the grantor herein, its successors or assigns, shall have a right to police said right-of-way upon condition however, that there shall be no interference with the use of said spur track by the grantee herein, its successors or assigns.
