

Reissue R and R. 1, The United States of America.
Montgomery Alabama. To all to whom these presents
shall come Greeting:
Know ye, That in pursuance of the Acts of Congress

appropriating and granting Land to the late Army of the United States, (passed on and since the sixth day of May 1812, "Enoch Kenyon, Richard Kenyon and Margaret Kelsey, the brothers and sister and only heirs at law of Gardner Kenyon decd, who was a private in the Company commanded by Captain E. Gilbert of the twenty third Regiment U. States Infantry," having deposited in the General Land Office a Warrant in their favor numbered 28061, and the said warrant having been duly assigned to Walter C. Arthur, There is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Walter C. Arthur, the east half of the northwest quarter and the west half of the northeast quarter of section two in Township twenty-one south of Range four west of the Huntsville Meridian Alabama, containing one hundred fifty nine and seventy hundredths acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress approved 27th July 1842; To Have And To Hold the said Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Walter C. Arthur and to his heirs and assigns forever.

This patent is issued in lieu of one dated October 3, 1866 which has been cancelled because of an error in the description.

In Testimony Whereof I Woodrow Wilson President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
