To have and to hold the same unto the said Francis Isbell, her executors, administrators and assigns forever and I covenant for myself my heirs, executors and administrators with the said Francis Isbell to warrant and defend the sale of said stock unto the said Francis Isbell her executors, administrators and assigns against all and every person lawfully claiming or to claim the same whosoever.
