That certain part of the East half of the Northeast fourth or quarter of section four, township twenty, Range one East with boundaries as follows: starting at a white oak tree 42 or 43 yards northeast of the center of west boundary line of said tract, (E. of N.E. 1/4 Sec. 4, Town 20, R. 1 E) and going thence northeasterly 320 yards to the mouth of middle ditch thence East 106 yards to the section line between Sections 3 & 4 in said Township 20 R. 1 E, thence South 159 yards to Yellow Leaf Creek, thence up said Yellow Leaf Creek 354 yards to the mouth of Powell Branch, thence up said Powell branch West 145 yards to the mouth of a crooked ditch, thence up said crooked ditch North to Northwest 450 yards to the white oak tree or starting point, containing 30 acres more or less, except whatever amount of land as may be needed for a road fifteen feet wide and running across said tract from East to West or easterly and westerly direction by the white oak tree mentioned above as the starting point.
