

The State of Alabama, } Know all men by These Presents
 Shelby County. } that I Angeline R. Norris widow and
 Relative of H. F. Norris deceased under and by virtue of the
 authority given me in the last will and testament
 of said H. F. Norris and particularly item second of said
 will probated on the 18th day of May 1886 in the
 Probate Court of said County, which item second is in
 words and figures as follows:

Item Second -

I will unto my beloved wife Angeline R. Norris who
 has been my companion and wife in the full
 meaning of the term for fifty years, all the balance
 of my estate both real and personal or mixed of
 whatever kind that I may in any way own or be
 possessed of at my death for and during her life
 and as she has labored with me to accumulate
 my property I give and confer on her full and
 complete power and authority to sell and dispose
 of any or all of said property at any time she
 may desire or think advisable and to make and
 execute good and perfect titles to the same without
 any order of court or report thereof, my
 purpose being to give my said wife the same
 full and complete control of all the property
 herein bequeathed to her as I could in life exercise
 while she lives.

Now under and by virtue of the Power and authority
 aforesaid and in consideration of the sum of Three
 Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by S. J. Finley
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I do here-
 by grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
 S. J. Finley an undivided one half interest in and
 to the following described real estate to-wit:

The NW¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ Sec. 28 and NE¹/₄ of SE¹/₄ & the SE¹/₄
 of the NE¹/₄ Section 29 Township 21 Range 1 West
 situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

To Have and To Hold the aforesaid premises to the
 said S. J. Finley his heirs and assigns forever, and I
 hereby covenant with the said S. J. Finley that I am lawfully
 seized in fee of said premises by the power conveyed

in item second of said will and that the above lands are a part of the lands belonging to the estate of A. S. Norris deceased and bequeathed to me by said will and I hereby covenant that I will forever warrant and defend the title to the said half interest in said land against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever.
