who being duly sworn says upon oath that affiant is the owner, and in possession of the West half of the Southwest quarter of Section 34 and the northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 33, all in Township 17, South, Range 1 East in Shelby County, Alabama. That said lands were conveyed to affiant by D. R. Isbell and wife on November 16th 1903, and that affiant thereupon went into possession of said lands and has been in open, notorious, adverse possession of same since the date of said deed. That affiant has known said lands for more than twenty years and that Henry Isbell, who conveyed said lands to D. R. Isbell, was in open, notorious, adverse possession of said lands from December 24th 1890, on which date a portion of said lands were conveyed to Henry Isbell by John Berryhill by warranty deed & that date until the day that he conveyed the same to D. R. Isbell which was on March 11th 1903, and that the said Henry Isbell claimed said 120 acres as his own during the time that he so owned same and was in possession thereof. That immediately after he sold and conveyed the said lands to D. R. Isbell, the said D. R. Isbell went into possession of same and remained thereon until the date on which the said D. R. Isbell and wife conveyed the said lands to affiant. That affiant has lived in the neighborhood of said lands practically all his life and he has never heard of any other person than the said Isbells claiming any title to said lands since the same was purchased by and conveyed to the said Isbell as aforesaid, and that no person has claimed any interest in said lands since affiant has been the owner and in possession of same.
