

The State of Alabama, } Before me J. E. Ruffin a N. P. Ex off. J. P.
 Shelby County } Sworn and for said State and County
 personally appeared Jas. Lindsey, who is known to me,
 and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says:
 That during the years hereafter named he was acquaint-
 ed with a certain tract of land situated in Shelby Coun-
 ty, Alabama described as follows to-wit:

Southwest quarter of section twenty five (25) Township twenty
 one (21) range four (4) west, and the South half of
 southeast quarter of section twenty six (26) Township twen-
 ty one (21) range four (4) west and the Northeast quarter
 of northwest quarter of section thirty six (36) Township
 twenty-one (21) range four (4) west.

That during the fall of the year 1866, or the spring of 1867
 the exact date of which affiant does not ^{now} remember
 affiant purchased said lands from one Joel W.
 Walker and received a deed from said Walker convey-
 ing said lands. That affiant does not ^{now} remember
 just exactly the nature of said deed or its provisions
 but does remember that a deed was made by said
 Walker to him conveying said lands. That ^{thereon} upon
 either in the latter part of the year 1866, or the first
 of the year 1867, affiant moved on said lands. That
 he used part of it as a homestead and that he cul-
 tivated the balance of it. That affiant remained
 in possession of said lands until sometime in
 November 1868 when he moved away from it.

That in the early part of the year 1869 affiant rent-
 ed said lands to one Malissa Faulkenberry who
 thereupon moved on said lands and remained in
 the possession of the same until affiant on to-wit
 the 8th day of October, 1869, sold said lands to one
 Jas. Lally. That during the time of her said ten-
 antcy the said Malissa Faulkenberry actually liv-
 ed on said lands though affiant is not sure
 that she cultivated any part of the same.
