 Shelby County, } That whereas an execution issued
 from and out of the city Court of Birmingham
 Jefferson County, Alabama, against E. W. Brandon, J. E.
 Shrumell and Sam H. Pledger in favor of Leeds State
 Bank, a corporation on a judgment rendered in said
