side of said last described forty (40) rods wide, all
in Section 16, Township 20 South of Range 3 West,

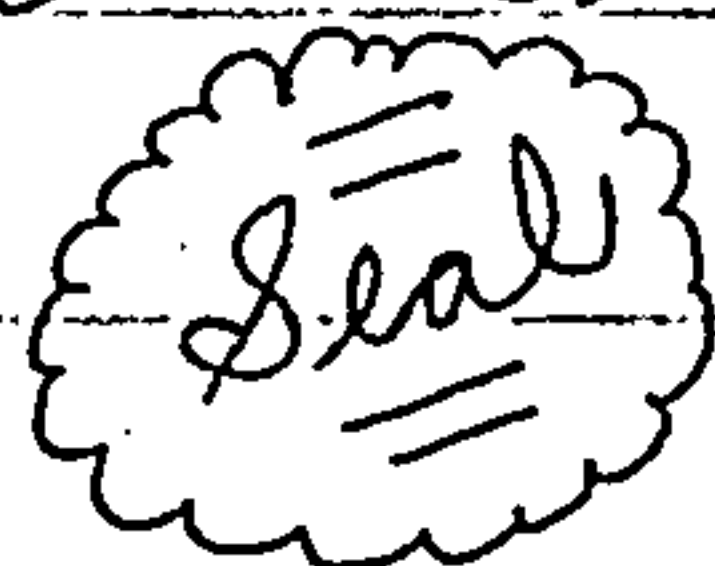
