R., and also excepting a strip across the north side of the S E 1/4 of N E 1/4 of said section, containing about three acres belonging to the Shelby Iron Company, and also excepting about three acres described as beginning 95 yards north of the south line of the S E 1/4 of N E 1/4 of said section 18 on the east side of the L & N. R. R. right of way, and running east 70 yards, thence north 210 yards, thence west 70 yards thence south 210 yards to the point of beginning.
