 bargained & sold & do by these presents, grant, bargain,
 sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part
 the following described Real estate lying in the County of
 Shelby State of Alabama to-wit: N¹/₂ of S¹/₄ and
 S¹/₄ of the S¹/₄ all in section 27 T. 19 R. 1 E.
 To have and to hold to the said party of the second part
 & to his heirs & assigns forever & said George McCary
 & Mary C. McCary of the first part covenant with the
 said W. R. McCary of the second part that they are
 lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises
 that they are free from all incumbrances and that
 they have a good right to sell & convey the same
 that they will & their heirs, executors & administrators
 shall warrant and defend the same to said W. R. McCary
 of the second part & his heirs and assigns forever
 against the lawful claims of all persons - In testimony
