them in hand paid by the said parties of the second
part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have

sold and hereby sell, confirm and convey unto the said party of the second part the following described land lying in Shelby County and State of Alabama to-wit: The South East quarter of the North East quarter and the North East quarter of the South East quarter of section Twenty and the west half of the North west quarter of section Twenty one of Township Twenty one of Range one East containing one hundred and sixty acres more or less.

To have and to hold the said parcels land with its appurtenances and premises unto the said Andy Cunnorton his heirs and assigns forever, we the said Young W. Ray and Rachel Ray, wife of the said Y. W. Ray for ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators warrant and will by these presents forever defend the right and title to said tracts and parcels of land unto the said Andy Cunnorton his heirs and assigns of all other persons whatsoever.
