To All to whom these Presents shall Come. Greeting;
 Whereas, Richard Wood, Assignee of Mitchell A. Porter, has been
 furnished with the Secretary of the Board of Trustees of the Uni-
 versity of Alabama, a Certificate of the Agent of the Trustees
 of said Institution, whereby it appears that full payment has
 been made by the said Richard Wood Assignee, according
 to the provisions of Act Number forty one, in the Town of Man-
 terello, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said
 Lands, furnished by the Surveyor General, which said tract
 has been purchased by the said Richard Wood Assignee of Mitchell
 A. Porter.

Now know ye, that the Trustees of the University of Alabama,
 in Consideration of the Premises, and in Conformity with the
 Ordinances of the Board of Trustees, passed in pursuance of
 the Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Alabama, in such
 cases made and provided, have given and granted, and by
 these presents do give and grant unto the said Richard
 Wood Assignee &c and to his heirs, the said tract above
 described to have and to hold together with all the rights,
 privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever
 nature there to belonging, unto the said Richard Wood
 Assignee of Mitchell A. Porter and to his assigns forever.
 In Witness whereof, I, A. P. Bayley, President of the Board
 of Trustees of the University of Alabama, have caused these
 Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the Corporation
 to be hereunto affixed.
