

The State of Alabama, { Know all men by these Presents,  
 the County of Shelby, } That I, and in Consideration of the  
 sum of Twenty four hundred and 00/100 (\$2400) dollars  
 cash, in liquid paid the undersigned George R. Moon by  
 Harmonia Schwartz (of Evansville, Indiana), the receipt of  
 which is hereby acknowledged, the said George R. Moon  
 hereby grants, conveys, sells, transfers, assigns and conveys  
 unto said Harmonia Schwartz the following described prop-  
 erty, namely:

That certain mortgage executed by L. H. Nabors and  
 wife Alice M. Nabors to George R. Moon dated January 17<sup>th</sup>  
 1917, and filed for record in the office of the Probate  
 Judge of Shelby County, Alabama, and recorded in Mortgage  
 Book 721, at page 48.

And the indebtedness therein described and  
 secured thereby, namely:

One note for \$800<sup>00</sup>, payable on or before Sept. 26, 1917.  
 One note for \$800<sup>00</sup>, payable on or before Sept. 26 - 1918; and  
 One note for \$700<sup>00</sup>, payable on or before Sept. 26 - 1919;  
 said notes being dated January 17, 1917, executed by  
 said L. H. Nabors to George R. Moon, and each bearing  
 interest from Sept. 26, 1916, at the rate of 8% per annum;  
 And, also, the property described in and conveyed by said  
 Mortgage hereinabove mentioned.

And it is hereby expressly understood and agreed that  
 this transfer is made with full recourse upon the  
 said George R. Moon, who has endorsed said notes.
