The North West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Thirty-Two (32) Township Twenty (20) Range Two (2) West, situated in Shelby County and State of Alabama, said tract of land containing forty acres more or less, the timber herein conveyed, being such as would be considered Merchantable Timber. It is understood and agreed that the Saginaw Lumber & Lumber Company have the right of-way upon and through said land for the purpose of removing the timber from said land and it is understood and agreed that the Saginaw Lumber & Lumber Company have until the 25th day of Jan. 1917 to remove said timber.
