 Shelby County, } in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00)
 Dollars to the undersigned grantor Shelby County State Bank, a Corpora-
 tion, in hand paid by the Columbian Savings Bank, a Corpora-
 tion, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned
 grantor, said Shelby County State Bank, a Corporation, does grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto the said Columbian Savings
 Bank, a Corporation, the following described property, to-wit:
 One lot or parcel of land in the town of Columbiana, Alabama, bounded
 as follows: Beginning at the N.E. Corner of the lot formerly owned by
 J. H. Massey, now owned by A. P. Leathers, and being twenty three
 and one half North from the N.E. Corner of the Columbian
 Savings Bank building and on the West side of Main street, and
 running North along the West side of Main street forty and
 one half feet more or less to the S.E. Corner of the brick store now
 occupied by the Columbian Drug Company, formerly occupied by
 the City Drug Company, thence running West along South side of said
 Drug Store or Drug Store lot one hundred twenty eight feet and
 nine inches more or less to the lot formerly owned by C. W. O'Hara,
 thence South forty and one half feet along line of said C. W. O'Hara
 lot, thence East one hundred, twenty eight feet and nine inches more
 or less to the point of beginning. Also all rights and privileges of
 Shelby County State Bank of joining to the South wall of the building
 known as the Drug Store Building, formerly occupied by the
 City Drug Company, now occupied by the Columbian Drug Com-
 pany, and all the rights in said wall or any wall that may
 replace the same which was conveyed by E. A. Hall to Gordon
 D. Rose, on January 15, 1902, by deed recorded in Vol. 24 of
 Deeds, page 574. Also a perpetual easement on thirteen in-
 ches off of the northern part of a lot in the town of Columbiana,
 Alabama, extending in a straight line immediately West and
 from the rear of the South wall of the Drug Store building
 on the West side of Main street formerly occupied by the
 City Drug Company, now occupied by the Columbian Drug

Company, said strip of thirteen inches extending West from said
 corner of said south wall of said brick stone building to
 the Eastern boundary line of said lot formerly owned and oc-
 cupied by C. W. O'Hara, and bounded on the South by the
 lots above described, said easement consists of the right to
 build and keep a brick wall or walls at all times on
 said thirteen inch strip or any part of the same and to
 join the same to the rear of said southern wall of said brick
 stone building or any wall that may replace the same.
 It is intended by this deed to convey to said Columbiana
 Savings Bank the same rights as were conveyed to the
 grantor herein by Henry Milner and Mayo Milner by deed
 dated October 13, 1911, said rights having been conveyed
 to the said Henry Milner and Mayo Milner by J. H. Aber-
 crombie and F. E. Abercrombie by deed dated November 9th
 1905; said rights having been conveyed to said J. H. Aber-
 crombie and F. E. Abercrombie by H. B. Brown, J. T. Leiper,
 H. L. Forley, Daisy Forley and Lizzie B. Brown by deed
 dated August 17, 1904, and recorded in the office of Judge
 of Probate at Columbiana, Alabama, in Vol. 31 of Record of
 Deeds page 180, and the same rights are reserved to
 said H. B. Brown and others in this deed as were
 reserved to them in the above mentioned deeds. This
 deed is made subject to an agreement as to an alley
 twenty feet wide on the West side of the lots herein de-
 scribed made by and between J. H. Abercrombie, H. B.
 Brown, J. T. Leiper, H. L. Forley and H. S. Parker on the
 17th day of August, 1904, and recorded in the Probate
 Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Vol. 29 of Record of
 Deeds on page 234, and it is understood and agreed
 that the said Columbiana Savings Bank and its successors
 and assigns shall be bound by said agreement. Also all
 fixtures situated in that part of the building on said property
 above described known as the Shelby County State Bank
 building in which the said Shelby County State Bank is
 now conducting a banking business. All situated in
 Shelby County, Alabama.

To Have and to hold to the said Columbiana Savings
 Bank, its successors and assigns forever.
 And the said Shelby County State Bank, a Corporation, does

for itself and its successors and assigns Covenant with the said ^{TOP} Columbian Savings Bank, its successors and assigns that it is lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all incumbrances and that it has a good right to sell and convey the same, as aforesaid; that it will and its successors and assigns shall warrant and defend the same to the said Columbian Savings Bank, a Corporation, its successor and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.
