 acknowledged, have bargained and sold and - these pres-
 ents do grant bargain, sell and convey unto the said party
 of the second part the following described land lying in
 Shelby County and State of Alabama, to-wit: The West half
 of North West Quarter South East Quarter of North West Quarter
 and the North West Quarter of South West Quarter of Sec.
 Six (6) Township Nineteen (19) of Range One (1) East.
 To have and to hold to said second party, their heirs
 and assigns forever the above described and hereby
 granted lands and premises and the said parties
 of the first part husband and wife hereby Covenant

with the said part of the record part that they are lawfully seized of and have a good right to sell and convey said lands and hereby bind themselves their heirs and legal representatives forever to warrant and defend the title to said lands and premises to the said party of the record part, his heirs, assigns and legal representatives against the claims of all and every person in Law and Equity and against the Government of the United States.
