 dred and sixty acres more or less. To have and to hold the
 abovegranted lands and premises to the said Sarah M. Nabors
 her heirs and assigns to their use and behoof forever and
 we do hereby Covenant with the said Sarah M. Nabors that we
 are lawfully seized of (as Administrators aforesaid) of the
 abovegranted land and premises that we have a good right
 (as Administrators aforesaid) to sell and convey the same.
