Shulby County this 17th day of November A.D. 1870,
between Johna P. Pickel and Mary C. Pickel, husband and
wife of the first part and Hampton Rasco & Mary B. Rasco, of

of the second part Hitherto: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part the following described land lying in Shelby County and State of Alabama, to-wit: The S. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Twenty Nine and the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Thirty two, in Township Nineteen of Range One East. To have and to hold to said second parties their heirs and assigns forever, the above described and hereby granted lands and premises. And the said parties of the first part, husband and wife, hereby Covenant with the said party of the second part that they are lawfully seized of and have a good right to sell and convey said land and hereby bind themselves, their heirs and legal representatives forever to warrant and defend the title to said land and premises to the said party of the second part their heirs assigns and legal representatives against the claims of all and every person in law or equity and against the Government of the United States.
