 first part and William Spearman of - - party of the
 second part; It is covenanted that the said party of the first part
 for and in consideration of the sum of \$400⁰⁰ four hundred
 Dollars to him in hand paid by the said party of the second
 part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said
 party of the first part - bargained and sold, and do by
 these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
 party of the second part the following described real
 estate lying in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama,
 to-wit: S. W. 1/4 of S. E. 1/4 of Sec. 29 and the N. W. 1/4 of the N. E. 1/4
 Sec. 32 in Township 19 Range 4 E and part of the S. E. 1/4
 of the S. W. 1/4 lying East of the Pumpkin Swamp Road in
 Sec. 29 Township 19 R. 4 E, containing 98 acres more or less.
 To have and to hold to the said party of the second part,
 and to their heirs and assigns forever. And said party
 of the first part Covenant with the said party of the second
 part, that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of said
 premises: that they are free from all incumbrances, and
 that they have a good right to sell and convey the same,
 that they will and their heirs, executors and Administrators
 shall warrant and defend the same to said
 party of the second part and their heirs and assigns
 forever against the lawful Claims of all persons.
