Half of the S. E. 1/4 of the N. W. 1/4 bounded as follows: the mode line commencing at the N. W. Corner of the forty and running straight to the S. E. Corner of the forty and thence to the N. E. Corner of the forty and from thence to the N. W. Corner of the forty at the starting point, containing 20 acres more or less, all in sec. 17, Tp. 19 N. R. 2 E. Also commencing at a certain mark on the bank of the river at the top of the bank at the corner where T. M. Aclon's land starts; thence in a straight line across the bottom in a S. E. direction with T. M. Aclon's line to a certain mulberry tree at the upper edge of the pond at the foot of the ridge; thence in the same direction to the E. W. line, thence E. along the line until you come opposite the big gate thence N. W. by said gate along that road to the river thence down the river to the starting point including a part of the N. 1/2 of the N. W. 1/4 and part situated in Jefferson County, Alabama.
