by said, sold, aliened, conveyed and conveyed, and by the present to grant, bargain, sell, convey and convey to the said John Thomas all that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama and more particularly described as follows to wit: The North West Quarter of the South East Quarter (NE 1/4 of SE 1/4) and the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter (NE 1/4 of SW 1/4) Section Eleven (11) Township Twenty (20) Range Two (2) East containing Eighty acres more or less.

To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land together with the tenements and appurtenances thereto belong or otherwise appertaining unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever. And the said P. L. Chancellor and Bell Chancellor of the first part for themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators do warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the said party of the second part - her heirs and assigns from and against themselves, and all and every person claiming to hold under them the said party of the first part, and against the lawful title, claim or demand of all and every person whatsoever.
