 second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have  
 sold, and hereby sell, confirm and convey unto the said  
 party of the second part the following described land lying  
 in Shelby County, State of Alabama to-wit: a part of the  
 S. W. 1/4 of the N. W. 1/4 of Section No. 14 Township 21, Range No. 3  
 West, the Commence on the Section line on the West side of  
 said numbers at a Pin-Point Corner and run East  
 8 rods, thence North 20 Rods, thence West to the Section  
 line, the Area on which the buildings of the said  
 Jasper Goodson are situated, to have and to hold to  
 said second party, his heirs and assigns forever, the  
 above described and hereby granted lands and premises  
 And the said parties of the first part, husbands and wives  
 hereby covenant with the said party of the second part,  
 that we are lawfully seized of, and have good right to sell  
 and convey said land, and hereby bind ourselves, our  
 heirs and legal representatives forever, to warrant and  
 defend the title to said land and premises to the said  
 party of the second part, his heirs, assigns and legal  
 representatives, against the claim of all and every per-  
 son in law or equity and against the government  
 of the United States.
