

This Indenture made and entered into this the 23rd day of July A.D. 1870 between Abraham Naish and Mary Naish his wife of the first part and Jasper Goodson of the second part all of the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, Witnesses: That for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to them in hand paid by the said Jasper Goodson, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both this day bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents both bargain, sell and convey unto the said Jasper Goodson all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, to-wit: Commencing at the South East-Corner of the N. E $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. E $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, in Township 21 of Range 3 West and running due West to a stake on the top of the hill, thence North to a stake on the same hill, thence East to the section line thence South to the Commencing Corner containing Nine acres more or less in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama together with all and singular the appurtenances, hereditaments and rights in anywise appertaining unto the said Jasper Goodson his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Abraham Naish and Mary Naish his wife for themselves their heirs, executors and Administrators doth warrant and will well defend the right and title to the above described and hereby conveyed premises unto the said Jasper Goodson his heirs and assigns from and against the claim of them the said Abraham Naish and Mary Naish and all and every person or persons claiming or holding under or by the said Abraham & Mary Naish and also against the lawful title claim or demand of all and every person or persons ^{whomever} claiming or holding by or from under the General Government of the United States of America.
