 sell, remise, release, alien and confirm unto the said party

 in the settlement of Dismarant, County of Shelby and State  
 of Alabama and described as follows, to-wit: An undivided  
 (1/2) one half interest in Lots Nineteen (19) Twenty (20) Twenty  
 one (21) Twenty-two (22) in Block Twenty-eight (28) in Dismarant  
 Park, according to a survey made of the same by A.  
 J. Grefenkamp (surveyor) and as recorded in Map Record  
 Vol. 1 Page 24 in the office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County  
 together with all and singular the hereditaments and ap-  
 purtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining,  
 To Have and to Hold the said premises as above described  
 with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part  
 and to her heirs and assigns forever. And the said  
 Samr McAlroy and Debbie McAlroy parties of the first  
 part, their heirs, executors and administrators do covenant  
 grant, bargain and agree to and with the said party of  
 the second part her heirs and assigns that at the time of the  
 making and delivery of these presents they are well seized of  
 the above granted premises in Fee simple; that they are free  
 from all incumbrances whatever, and that they will and  
 their heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant  
 and defend the same against all lawful claims whatsoever.
