 poses and says that, heretofore, more than twenty years ago,
 he executed to E. B. Walker, a certain mortgage for five
 hundred fifty Dollars, in which he intended to describe
 and convey land in Section eight Township Twenty-two,
 Range Three West Shelby County, Alabama, but part of
 which land was described as North half of the South-
