Whereas Harry Brazier of Shelby County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa in Alabama, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Harry Brazier according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the West half of the North West Quarter of Section Three, in Township Twenty Six, of Range One East in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama, containing eighty acres and forty seven hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Harry Brazier.

Now Know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and Granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Harry Brazier the said tract above described.

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Harry Brazier and his heirs and assigns forever.
